Although our faith has always been small and our prayers infrequent and weak, God has been more than faithful to "supply all our needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:19). However, in these last two years we have been overwhelmed by His kind providence. Without any public appeal on our part, our number of donors increased at an astounding rate and donations more than doubled.


It has never been, nor is it now, our intention to store up resources when the need on the field is beyond measure. However, this increase must not be spent indiscriminately simply because it is there. HeartCry, the churches that partner with us, and the churches on the field will answer for every cent before the throne of God. For this reason, we petition your prayers that in the next several months we might walk in reverence, discern the will of God, and advance the Great Commission in ways that we never imagined possible.

We have already identified new fields, missionaries, and projects in areas of the world where we have labored for years and in places we have yet to reach. From the deepest jungles of South Asia to the metropolitan cities of Europe, we hope to increase the number of church planters and provide them with the resources necessary to establish churches. We are planning vast increases in the distribution of Bibles and literature, procurement of evangelistic tools, and provision of facilities for the gathering of the saints. We are also focusing our attention on those areas in Europe and the Middle East where the high cost of maintaining a missionary on the field has led to a dearth of laborers and left entire cities with little gospel light.

Please join us in prayer that God might increase our fear of Him. Although we are burdened with the weight of this stewardship, we also look forward with great excitement to honoring Christ, advancing His kingdom, and providing for the needs of His people. In July, we will be sending a mid-year report on how the surplus is being administered.

EXPENSES: \$6.049M
