2022 MISSION REPORT



Dear Brother and Sister in Christ,

"To those who are the called, beloved in God the Father, and kept for Jesus Christ: May mercy and peace and love be multiplied to you." - Jude 2

This last year surpassed the previous in global turmoil and growing opposition to the Christian faith. We see nation rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and in various places there are famines and earthquakes. False prophets have arisen and misled many. The devil has taken off his mask to parade in the street in broad daylight. Immorality is now considered virtue and biblical virtue considered immorality. Because of this increased lawlessness, human love has grown cold: babies are slaughtered for convenience and those who survive are corrupted. A significant portion of the professing church in the West has fallen away and joined the world in its hatred of the biblical Christ, of His cross, and of those who hold to His Word. In regions such as the 10/40 Window our brothers and sisters are delivered to tribulation and killed for the sake of the Name. These are dark times. Yet in the midst of darkness we have the privilege of standing fast with the light of the gospel. Jesus has promised that those who endure to the end will be saved, and:

"This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all the nations, and then the end will come." – Matthew 24:14

This is not a time for retreat, or even to hold the line. This is a time to throw ourselves into the heat of the battle and move the line forward. Let us be like Jonathan who said to his armor bearer, "Come and let us cross over to the garrison of these uncircumcised; perhaps the LORD will work for us, for the LORD is not restrained to save by many or by few" (I Samuel 14:6). Let us emulate Eleazar, one of David's mighty men, who defied the Philistines and struck them until his hand was weary and clung to the sword. The LORD brought about a great victory that day (II Samuel 23:9-10). Will He not give us an even greater victory if we fight for the Son of David and march forward, wielding the sword of the Spirit, the Word of God?

In this 2022 Mission/Financial Report, you will find a representative display of what God accomplished for His Son through your prayers and giving. In this last year...

- We have added 66 new missionary families, bringing us at the start of 2023 to a total of 326.
- We have entered into 8 new fields of labor in the countries of Antigua, Costa Rica, Hungary, Paraguay, Philippines, Ireland, Denmark, and Armenia.
- We have completed 170+ major projects in pastoral training, evangelistic tools, Bible and literature translation and distribution, aid to the persecuted church, benevolence, and construction.

We hope that the contents of this report will move you to join with us in praise and thanksgiving to our God, "Who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and manifests through us the sweet aroma of the knowledge of Him in every place." (II Corinthians 2:14)

hroughout the year of 2022, we have been praying about the great needs in the world and God's direction for HeartCry in the next decade. Not wanting to be merely subjective, we searched the Scriptures to identify the objective goals that the Lord set before His church. One goal in particular came to the forefront. It is found in Matthew 24:14:

"This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all the nations, and then the end will come." With the certainty of Scripture we know that it is the Lord's will for the gospel be preached to the whole world. When we survey the nations, we discover that the overwhelming majority of unreached people groups are found in the 70 countries of the 10/40 window.

The "window" represents a rectangular area on the globe between 10- and 40-degrees north latitude. It includes North Africa, the Middle East, and Asia.

QUICK FACTS About the window:

IT IS HOME TO APPROXIMATELY 5.27 BILLION PEOPLE IN 8,886 PEOPLE GROUPS.

IT IS THE MOST UNEVANGELIZED REGION OF THE GLOBE, CONTAINING 3.25 BILLION PEOPLE IN 6,188 PEOPLE GROUPS WHO ARE CURRENTLY BEYOND THE REACH OF THE GOSPEL.

IT CONTAINS 90% OF THE POOREST PEOPLE IN THE WORLD, EXISTING ON LESS THAN \$200 A MONTH.

IT IS CALLED "THE RESISTANT BELT" BECAUSE OF ITS RESISTANCE TO THE GOSPEL AND ITS PERSECUTION OF THE CHURCH. IT IS DOMINATED BY THREE RELIGIOUS BLOCKS THAT ARE ADVERSE TO CHRISTIANITY — ISLAM, BUDDHISM, AND HINDUISM.

IT IS THE MOST INACCESSIBLE REGION FOR WESTERN AND CROSS-CULTURAL MISSIONARIES.

IT IS ESTIMATED THAT LESS THAN 5% OF THE GLOBAL MISSIONARY FORCE SERVE IN THE 10/40 WINDOW.

IT IS ESTIMATED THAT LESS THAN 1% OF ALL MISSION GIVING GOES TO THE 10/40 WINDOW.

n the "2021 HeartCry Financial Report" we asked our partners to pray with us that God would open the door to new fields of labor and new partnerships with indigenous churches so that we might support more worthy missionaries. It is our joy to announce to you that the Lord has answered our prayers. In fact He has done exceedingly and abundantly above all that we asked or even hoped:

In 2022 HeartCry added 66 new missionary families across the globe, bringing us to a total of 326 missionaries in 62 countries on 5 continents.

This is wonderful news, but in the above statistics one of the most exciting aspects is that God has opened the door for us to support 18 new missionary families in 8 new countries where we have never labored. These countries are Antigua, Costa Rica, Hungary, Paraguay, Philippines, Ireland, Denmark, and Armenia. "Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift!" (II Corinthians 9:15)

It is such a great privilege, not only to labor in these new countries and support these worthy men and women, but also to witness God's bountiful answers to prayer. His faithfulness should strengthen our faith and encourage us to continue to ask Him for a greater and greater harvest for His Son. As He promised in Psalm 2:8: "Ask of Me, and I will surely give the nations as Your inheritance, and the very ends of the earth as Your possession."



NEW MISSIONARY POPULATION: 1,321,000


















he pages that follow contain representative samples of these 170+ projects. HeartCry's ministry on the field can be divided into two major categories: the support of missionaries and the endowment

of special projects for the advancement of the Great Commission and the benefit of God's people—especially the persecuted and suffering. These special projects may be further divided into five subcategories: Training, Literature, Ministry Resources (Resourcing), Chapel Construction, and Benevolence & Aid to the Persecuted.

Literature

Many Christians in remote parts of the world do not own a Bible. Many indigenous missionaries and pastors on the field do not have an adequate library to aid them in the study of the Scriptures. In view of such needs, Heart-Cry labors in the translation and distribution of Bibles, pastoral libraries, and theological works.

Resourcing

The work of indigenous missionaries is often limited by the lack of proper tools for ministry. After careful research, HeartCry provides these tools so that the missionaries may fulfill the work to which the Lord has called them. Examples of ministry tools that HeartCry has provided in the past include boats and motors for travel on the remote rivers of South America and Asia, horses and mules for travel in rural and mountainous regions, bicycles, motorcycles, automobiles, sound systems, projectors, computers, software, etc.

Chapel Construction

Many congregations on the foreign field are limited in their ministry by not having an adequate meeting place. Oftentimes, struggling congregations must use the offerings they receive to pay the rent for a facility that is woefully inadequate or may be lost from week to week. As a result, they can never save the necessary capital to purchase their own land or begin construction. After careful examination, HeartCry will provide the funds for a congregation to procure an adequate facility, via the purchase of property, the construction of a permanent structure, or the reimbursement of rental fees. Through the years this ministry has proven itself as an important means of advancing the kingdom.

Benevolence & Aid to the Persecuted

Our Lord has made it very clear that we are to care for the needs of His people, especially when they are suffering for the faith. On Judgment Day, Jesus will declare to the righteous, "Come, you who are blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. For I was hungry, and you gave Me something to eat; I was thirsty, and you gave Me something to drink; I was a stranger, and you invited Me in; naked, and you clothed Me; I was sick, and you visited Me; I was in prison, and you came to Me." (Matthew 25:34-36) The Apostle John writes, "But whoever has the world's goods, and sees his brother in need and closes his heart against him, how does the love of God abide in him? Little children, let us not love with word or with tongue, but in deed and trut.h" (I John 3:17-18) In response to Christ's commands, we are constantly looking and crying out for God to show us where His people are suffering so that we might respond in a prompt and biblical manner. This includes assisting the persecuted church, helping the destitute, caring for widows and orphans, and any other opportunity that divine providence might place before us. •••





his past year has been a time of great struggle and great advance. In 2022, by God's grace HeartCry's missionary force grew by 66 missionary families, bringing us at the start of 2023 to 326 missionaries in 62 countries across 5 continents. We have also completed more than 170 projects for the advancement of the gospel throughout the world.

For these advances we want to be careful to give all glory to God and to make known to you that this is more your victory than ours. We are only beneficiaries of your prayers and stewards of your generosity. We are merely the link between the men and women on the field who have gone out for the sake of the Name and those of you who have sent them on their way in manner worthy of God (III John 7-8). You have acted faithfully in all that you have accomplished for the brethren and they testify of your love before their churches (III John 5-6). Borrowing from Paul's encouragement to the church in Corinth we may say to you that the ministry of your service has not only fully supplied the needs of the saints but is overflowing with many thanksgivings to God. Missionaries throughout the world are praising God for your obedience to your confession of the gospel of Christ and for the liberality of your contribution to them (II Corinthians 9:12-13).

At HeartCry it has always been our purpose to be a voice for the indigenous missionaries who have none. At this moment, we want to use our voice to express our thanksgiving for all that you have done and to give you a report of our stewardship. As Paul writes in II Corinthians 8:20-21:

[We are] taking precaution so that no one will discredit us in our administration of this generous gift; for we have regard for what is honorable, not only in the sight of the Lord, but also in the sight of men."



We lament that not even half has been told, but we know that one day all will be revealed. Then we will rejoice together before the very throne of God!

MISSIONS:

1. In 2022, 88 % of all giving was allocated to the work of preaching, teaching and church planting.

2. The spearhead or vanguard of the Great Commission consists of elder-qualified men who are tested, approved, and sent out by biblically mature churches.

3. It is our conviction that although the Great Commission is difficult, it is not complicated. All that is required is putting the right man in the right place and providing him with the spiritual and material support he needs to carry out his mission.

ADMINISTRATION:

1. In 2022, 7% was allocated to administration. The national average for non-profits is between 15 to 25%.

2. We are able to keep our administrative cost far below the average through outsourcing administrative tasks and by allocating 0% to fundraising.

3. HeartCry's primary ministry is the financial support of missionaries. Therefore, a robust administrative team is essential, not only for accountability but to navigate the complexities of international communications and transactions.

MEDIA:

In 2022, 5% was spent on media. To understand this expenditure, we must consider the two primary purposes of our media ministry:

Remote Training Program: Every week, we film training videos in our studio to educate churches and missionaries in various languages and in some of the most remote parts of the world.

Mission Education Program: It is essential that God's people hear reports from the field about God's work, that they might be encouraged in their faith, glorify God, and learn about missions. This is accomplished through our documentaries, quarterly magazines, an annual calendar, and social media.

****Building Rent:** After thirty years of moving from office to office, HeartCry has entered into a lease/purchase agreement for a permanent office in Roanoke, Virginia. The cost of the lease/purchase has been covered by a designated giver and was not taken from the general fund. Praise God!
